### Z Went First

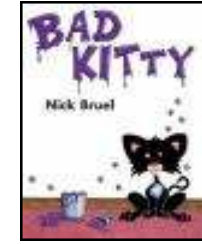
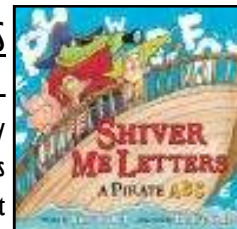

## BAD KITTY

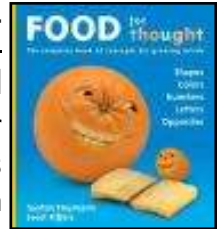
