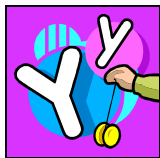
ABC x 3

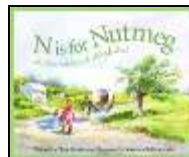
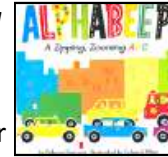


ACHOO! BANG! CRASH!: The Noisy Alphabet

From the American Museum of Natural History (A) to the Bronx Zoo (Z), an alphabetical exploration of places to visit and famous sites in the Big Apple.

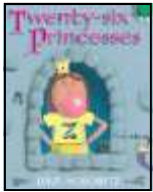

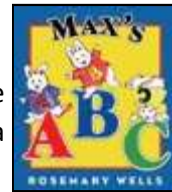

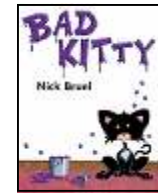
ALPHA OOPS: The Day Z Went First

E SOBEL



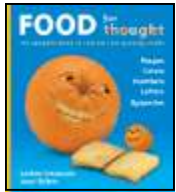
Bemoaning the fact that pirates only use the letter R, a captain and his motley crew of various animals attempt to press the remaining letters into service.
