

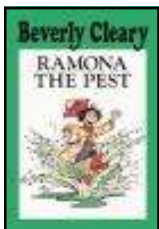


NASTY STINKY SNEAKERS

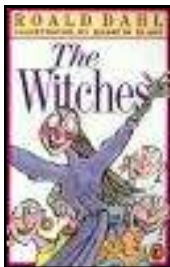
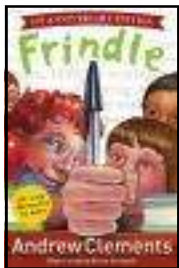
RAMONA THE PEST

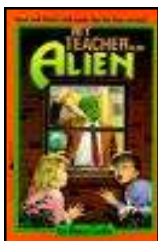


THE WITCHES

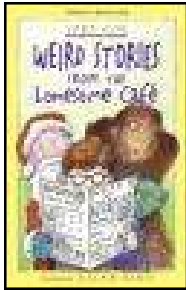

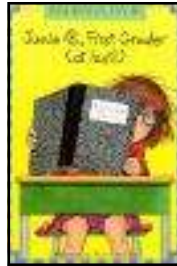


THE ADVENTURES OF CAPTAIN UNDERPANTS

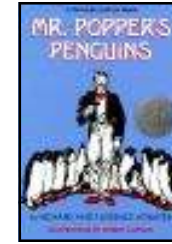

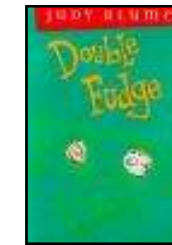
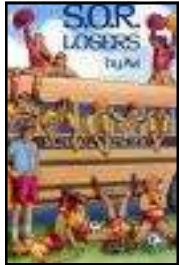
