



### THE ADORATION OF JENNA FOX

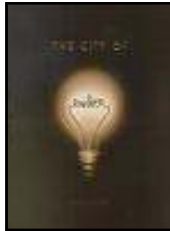

### THE COMPOUND

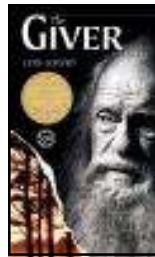

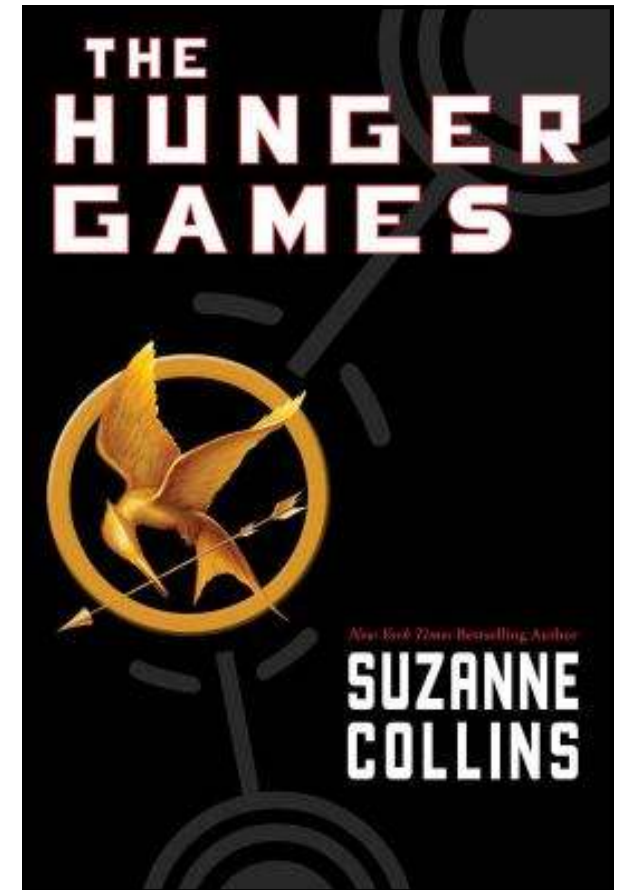


### THE ENEMY

### GRACELING

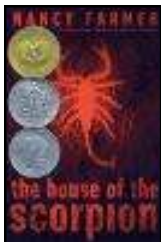

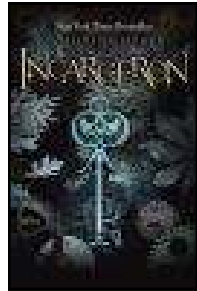

### INCARCERON

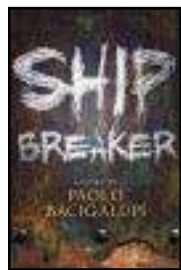
