SMILE, PRINCIPESSA!

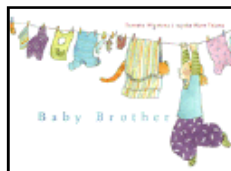

NEW BABY TRAIN

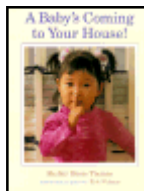

Adapted from the beloved song by Woody Guthrie, this picture book provides an imaginative answer to the oft-asked question, "Where do babies come from?"

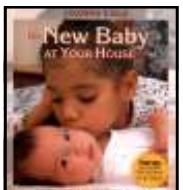

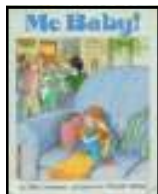

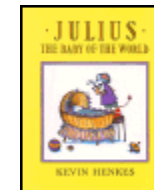
